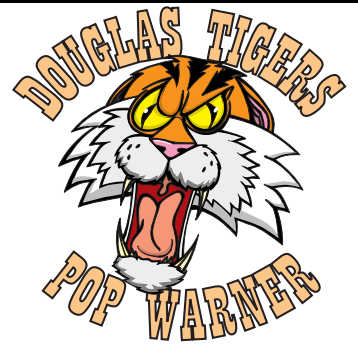

## LOPSIDED SCORE RULE

Pop Warner has a rule known as the Lopsided Score Rule that is designed to prevent a team from "piling it on". It is intended to preserve the self-esteem of a team that is outmatched on a given day. The rule kicks in when the point spread reaches 28. At that time the clock turns into a running clock. The winning team must make every effort to minimize the score including keeping the offensive running plays between the tackles, and moving players to different positions. Fumbles and interceptions may not be advanced and there is no blitzing by the winning team. You will often see a coach insert players in strange positions in order to minimize their team's scoring capability and to give the players some fun and different experiences. Passing is allowed by the winning team. If a pass is completed the play will continue until it is finished and then the ball placed at the spot of the completion. That is a rule only used in Sagebrush Empire as an experiment. Postseason lopsided games will not allow such passing.
