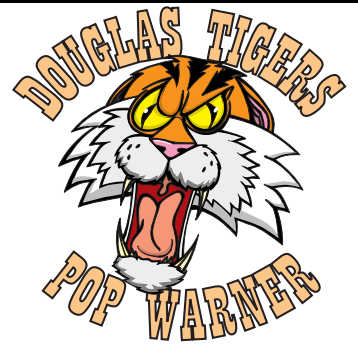

EQUIPMENT

Remember to check your player's equipment regularly. It is likely time to get a new mouthpiece if you haven't replaced the original one yet. They do get a bit raggedy after all that chomping. This is a very important piece of equipment as it protects your child's choppers and can save you a lot of dental bills. Other things to look for:

crazing on the helmet, cracks in the facemask, loose facemask screws, cracks in thigh pads, etc. If you have a question, or need replacement gear, contact your coach immediately.
