

IMPORTANT: Please make sure your guests comply with the policies and practices of Pop Warner when they come to watch your child play. Just because they are a guest doesn't mean they can drink, smoke, bring a dog, etc. Your help in orienting them is very much appreciated.

Remember to check your player's equipment regularly. It is likely time to get a new mouthpiece if you haven't replaced the original one yet. They do get a bit raggedy after all that chomping. This is a very important piece of equipment as it protects your child's choppers and can save you a lot of dental bills. Other things to look for: crazing on the helmet, cracks in the facemask, loose facemask screws, cracks in thigh pads, etc. If you have a question, or need replacement gear, contact your coach.
