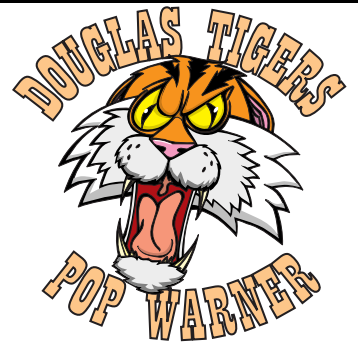

PARADE DETAILS

Everyone is invited to be with the Sagebrush Empire Nevada Day Parade float this Saturday. Wear your uniform, or an old one from an older brother or your parent as a "throwback". Here are some helpful directions for the morning of the parade:

We will be staged/meeting on Adeline St. in Carson City. We are float #34. You will need to drop off your child no later than 9:30am! 10yrs of age and younger will need to ride on the floats and older can walk. The easiest way to get there from Douglas is to take S. Carson St. headed north, left onto Rhodes St. right onto Curry and head North. Follow that to 10th St., left on 10th St., right onto Division St. then right onto Adaline St.

Pick up will be in the parking lot directly north/across from the Carson DMV on Stewart St. The parade starts at 10am and estimated will finish is 11-11:15am for us to be at DMV for pick up. If you have any questions call Austin at 775-220-0395.
