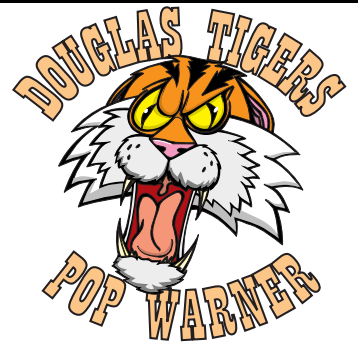

CERTIFIED WEIGHTS

Certified Weigh-in will be during practice on Thursday, August 25th. If your athlete is not here Thursday, or doesn't make weight, he/she can get certified at the Jamboree, or at a future special make up weigh session.

Weigh in Dress: For certified weigh-ins male players should dress in shorts and wear lightweight tee shirt. No shoes, socks okay. Parents must stand back.

JAMBOREE

The Annual Al Barbieri Jamboree takes place this Saturday in Fallon at the Churchill County Fairgrounds. This is a season kick-off scrimmage where your team will play other teams for 30 minutes each. They'll play 15 minutes one way, offense or defense, and then switch. It is exciting as most of the 60-plus teams from Sagebrush will be there. It will also be crowded as there are four teams with all of their fans on each field! What fun!

Admission is free. Sagebrush assesses Cities for each athlete to participate. Your Board absorbs the cost rather than asking you to pay. FYI – other Cities charge their parents. Your friends from other programs may have paid a fee for this weekend. Another Tigerthon benefit. Plan for the heat – it can be a long day out there.
